Waste Management will provide curbside service with automated carts. Please have your carts out along the curb by 6am. Lids need to be closed to keep material inside, water and critters outside.

Basic service includes one (1) cart for trash, one (1) cart for household recycle, and up to two (2) carts for green waste. Each resident also receives one (1) bulky item pick up per year, up to four (4) items per pick up.

Additional carts and bulky item pick up are available for a fee. The homeowner or resident will be billed by Waste Management directly.

- Grass
- Leaves
- Tree branches
- Plants
- Weeds
- Garden Trimmings



### Please Do Not Include

- Palm fronds
- Soil
- Rocks
- Gravel
- Manure
- Animal waste
- Plastic bags

## Cart Service Reminders

1. Place all acceptable green waste items in the green waste cart and close the lid.
2. Any green waste items outside the cart will not be collected.
3. Place your carts at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on collection day.
4. Roll carts into the street and place them against the curb, handles facing your home. Place carts at least two feet apart from other carts and objects.

# Waste Management Bulky Item Collection

Residents served by Waste Management may request the pick up of household bulky items by calling **Waste Management at least 48** hours before their regular collection day. Up to six (6) items may be collected each time.
